 - a. Overview of next steps for TBUF 2024
 - b. Four decisions CJ wanted leadership team feedback on:
 - i. Format: Proposal for 2/2 and 3/1. 10 player base team additional fees for roster spots after that
 - ii. Location: Played on County land last time. County is larger, but more difficult to deal with. City easier to work with but beaches are narrower. Try to make the City side work.
